Please Read Carefully

- * Address and name changes must be processed by the DMV first. The DMV address change can be completed on the DMV website.
- * Complete form and mail with payment.
- * If lost/stolen, we recommend that you file a police report with the department/agency jurisdiction where the incident occurred.
- * If previous address is outside of Lane County and your CHL is not expired, you will need to do a transfer. Call 541-682-3906 to schedule.
- * If you have moved outside of Lane County, you will need to contact the County where you now reside for their transfer process.
- * If your CHL expires within the next year, you may decide that it is more economical to schedule an appointment and do a renewal. You would not be charged for changing your address separately. It will be part of the renewal process.
- * We will process and mail your updated changes within approximately two weeks.

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) require that CHL holder's keep their current ***physical address*** on file at all times with the issuer of their CHL. If you move to a different address in Lane County, you are required to change your address with us (ORS 166.295 (2)).
