The General Fund covers 1.0 FTE Supervisor, 1.0 FTE Mental Health Specialist 2, 1.0 FTE Juvenile Justice Nurse, 2.0 Bilingual Office Assistant 2, and 1.0 Office Assistant 2, 1.0 Victim Advocate.

State/Federal Mandate

ORS 169.740 states that juvenile facilities shall provide for counseling of any detained juvenile found to be within the jurisdiction of the court. ORS 169.076(5) states that juvenile detention facilities shall provide for emergency medical and dental health.
