Executive Summary

This position is the housing manager that will lead efforts to ensure that the TAC recommendations from the shelter feasibility study are achieved. While Sarai will be a county employee, she will hold a joint office with responsibilities to the Interim Eugene City Manager and the County Administrator. This implements the first phase of the homeless systems transformation report previously approved by the Board of Commissioners. Our goal is to pool these additional County funds with matching funds from our partners at the City of Eugene and invest in results-based solutions that bust barriers to housing, connect people to existing services, and catalyze system improvements to effectively end homelessness in Lane County.
