Our Lead Medical-legal Death Investigator, and Medical-legal Death Investigators work with law enforcement partners, the State Medical Examiner's pathologist assigned to Lane County and others to investigate and report cause and manner of death. Over 5 FTE are required to fully cover a 24/7 post, but Lane County is managing 24/7 coverage with three full-time employees, and a handful of part-time staff who agree to accept on-call shifts.
