**Executive Summary**

The District Attorney is responsible for the prosecution of all felony offenses and most misdemeanor offenses committed in Lane County. Due to a reduction of staff in 2012, we had severely compromised the effective prosecution of thousands of cases and failed to file over 1,000 viable cases per year from 7/2012-7/2015. Initially with grant funding, and subsequently with increased general fund support we are staffed to file all viable felony cases and the most significant misdemeanor cases.
