Executive Summary

FY 20-21 COVID impacts included CRT and TRT revenue decreases to Parks which was balanced with decreased reserves. The reduction of reserves in FY 20-21 also decreased Fund Balance Carryover for FY 21-22. This loan will provide upto \$110,000 operations revenue in FY 21-22 to Public Works Parks Division.

Maintain current service levels in Parks Operations.

Provide minimum level of services to keep parks, campgrounds, marinas, and waysides open for community and tourist use. Parks owns, operates or maintains 68 facilities throughout the County and offer camping, hiking, marinas, covered bridges, picnicking and access to Lane County waterways. Currently there are seven full-time Park Maintenance employees providing enforcement and maintenance roles. It is difficult to adequately maintain such a large park system with this small team even with temporary help during the summer season.
