MOTION

I move the Board approve Order No. 21-06-15-5 / IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING RENEWAL OF PURCHASED INSURANCE POLICIES AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE RISK MANAGER TO EXECUTE RENEWAL DOCUMENTS

I. AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

Lane County purchases various insurance policies, which include but are not limited to Property, Property Terrorism, Crime, Excess Casualty, Excess Casualty Terrorism, Cyber, Special Events, and Excess Workers' Compensation; these coverages expire July 1, 2021. Additional policies, such as Flood coverage on various buildings, have varying expiration dates.

The purpose of this item is to request a renewal of the purchased insurance policies at the previous coverage levels. The self-insured retention amounts, where applicable, remain the same.

II. BACKGROUND/IMPLICATIONS OF ACTION

A. Board Action and Other History

The Board has historically directed the purchase of certain insurance coverages to protect County Assets.

Pursuant to the terms of LC 2.410, Lane County is self-insured up to \$1,000,000 for General Liability claims, \$600,000 for Workers' Compensation (excluding police), and \$750,000 for police WC. In 2020 the County elected to purchase the following insurance coverages:

1. Crime Coverage up to \$1,000,000;
2. Cyber Coverage up to \$ -0-*;
3. Excess Casualty / Casualty Terrorism Coverage up to \$20,000,000;
4. Excess Workers' Compensation Coverage up to \$2,000,000;
5. Flood insurance coverages on properties in high risk flood zones, varying amounts of coverage based on building and content values;
6. Property and Property Terrorism up to \$200,000,000;
7. Various program specific coverages, including but not limited to:
 - a. Medical Malpractice Gap Coverage;
 - b. Search and Rescue (SAR) Volunteers Workers' Compensation;
 - c. Volunteer coverage (includes LCAC inmates, excludes SAR).

* Cyber coverage for 2021-2022 is very volatile for all municipalities. No insurance companies were willing to offer coverage as of June 2021. BBNW was able to secure an additional two months on the current policy (up to \$5,000,000) with the current carrier to allow Lane County the opportunity to make additional changes in order to hopefully be able to secure coverage for the remainder of 2021-2022. If coverage can be secured, a separate agenda item will be submitted to the Board for approval.

Flood coverage on properties located in Flood Zones and additional program/event specific coverages will continue to be purchased at the previously established coverage amounts.

B. Policy Issues

Insurance helps ensure some financial security from unexpected losses over the self-insured retention of \$1,000,000 (\$600,000/\$750,000 workers' compensation). Should the Board could chose to forego insurance and direct the reallocation of funds, the County would be financially responsible for all losses, and could potentially face drawing funds from other programs to pay for a large loss.

C. Board Goals

Purchase of insurance coverages would be consistent with the Board's commitment to prudent stewardship of public funds and resources by protecting County assets in the event of a large loss or losses.

D. Financial and/or Resource Considerations

The amount of coverage selected determines the premium assessed. In the past, the County attempted to balance the amount of coverage with the cost of the premium.

The increases in the annual premiums, excluding excess workers' compensation) are due to market expenses and fluctuations, not claims made by Lane County. The increase to excess workers' compensation coverage is as a result of an audit of the mandatory NCCI (National Council on Compensation Insurance) codes assigned to each employee position. The audit revealed some position codes were missing, causing a shortage in the estimated premiums paid. Working with HR and Finance a plan was developed to avoid this error in the future.

E. Health Implications

In the event of a disaster or catastrophe, the County may need to provide shelter and staging areas, increase Public Health involvement, and increase medical services to citizens. Receiving payment on a property policy could not only help construct temporary shelters and clinic areas to provide immediate assistance to the public, but may also help community resilience by allowing the County to rebuild permanent structures, permitting the County to provide services that are necessary for the community, such as issuance of building permits, inspections, animal services, among many others.

F. Analysis

Purchasing insurance coverage as listed above limits the County's loss exposure in the event of large damage awards or property destruction. Cancellation of these policies would result in a financial savings, but would increase the County's fiscal responsibility to 100% of any and all claims.

G. Alternatives/Options

1. Approve renewal of all insurance in coverage amounts previously established.
2. Increase and/or decrease additional or all coverage amounts;
3. Do not renew the coverages and elect to totally self-insure for all losses.

III. RECOMMENDATION

Option 1: Approve renewal of all insurance in coverage amounts previously established.

IV. TIMING/IMPLEMENTATION

Renewal is required by June 23, 2020, to insure no lapse in coverage occurs.

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

After nearly decade of insurance rate stability, the relatively soft market in property and general liability is gone and momentum continues to march towards a hard market increasing costs and constricting coverages. Prior to the COVID-19 Pandemic and economic shutdown, the losses in the US were larger and happening more often. Fires, floods, hurricanes, wildfires, tornadoes and windstorms all are happening more often and with greater strength leading to losses that are hitting the reinsurance market's already crippled balance sheets.

Enter the COVID-19 pandemic and economic shutdown just a few months ago. The insurance market, much like other facets of our way of life is still working through what immediate and long-term effects this pandemic will have on our lives and financial markets. When insurance underwriters lose confidence in a risk or in the market they are writing business in, they have two options: increase premiums or narrow their exposure to that risk (or the exit the market completely).

Excess Liability: Rates have increased substantially and we expect those same challenges to continue well into 2022 and perhaps 2023. We believe rates will continue to press upwards and coverage will erode for at least the next 12 to 24 months. Coverage for law enforcement and jails will continue to be problematic.

Property: The last 5 years have continued to see a parade of large national losses which are happening more often and with much greater strength. These losses are driving global reinsurance rates much higher resulting in higher costs to you, the retail consumer.

Cyber: The cyber insurance market is in complete disarray. Rates are increasing substantially and coverage is capacity is shrinking. Losses locally as well as nationally have caused the ransomware risk to be briskly moving towards uninsurable. It behooves all Oregon governmental entities to invest in staff as well as infrastructure to safeguard systems and data as much as possible

■ **AUTHORIZED ADMITTED INSURERS** An authorized or admitted insurer has been authorized to do business in the state of Oregon. When an authorized Oregon insurance company becomes insolvent and is liquidated by a court order, the Oregon Insurance Guaranty Fund will pay covered claims against insurers that were licensed to do business in Oregon at the time of the insolvency. The guaranty funds will not pay any claim the insurance company would not have paid. Claims are paid according to the terms of the original insurance policy.

■ **NON-ADMITTED INSURERS** If your policy charges surplus lines taxes then it is written with a non-admitted insurer. Marketing Comments:

Safety National has increased their rate by 9.5% and the insured's payroll is up by a whopping 22.5% which is driving up the premium.

The retention offered remains the same with an alternate at \$750K. Aircraft coverage is excluded again so you need to tell me if they plan on changing that and using aircraft again.

Prior to binding, we need to confirm to Safety National that Lane County's fuel storage is for their use only and not sold to the public.

Please also see enclosed quotes from Gray Insurance that offer a buffer layer that would reduce the SIR retention to a level lower than what the excess carrier is willing to offer. This is an option that the County may want to consider as market trends are that most carriers are seeking to increase SIR especially in Fire and Police exposures. Reducing the retention on 7720 (police) to \$600K might be of interest to the county, Gray policy forms enclosed for your review.
