## BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 22-03-29-14

In the Matter of Allocating American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding to Proposed Projects and Planning for Future Use of Funds that Align with Lane County Strategic Priorities.

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law 11-2) also called the COVID-19 Stimulus Package or American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, was passed by the 117th United States Congress and signed into law by President Joe Biden on March 11, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the ARPA provides for \$65.1 billion in direct allocation to counties. Lane County anticipates receipt of \$74,212,036 in total, to be paid in two equal payments, the first of which was received on May 19, 2021 and the second payment expected in May 2022; and

**WHEREAS,** ARP funds in the amount of \$54,878,000 were allocated to projects in Board Order 21-12-14-08

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

- **1.** ARP funds of \$9,949,000 are allocated to the following projects:
  - a. Economic Development \$722,000
  - b. Parks Water and Sewer Infrastructure (#59) \$4,277,000
  - c. Countywide Grant Administration Software (#10) \$450,000
  - d. Community Grant-Making Process \$3,000,000
  - e. Holiday Farm Fire Permit Services \$1,500,000
