ORDER NO: 22-06-21-15

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE  
ALLOCATION OF AMERICAN RESCUE  
PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDS FOR YOUTH  
SUICIDE PREVENTION

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law 11-2) also called the COVID-19 Stimulus Package or American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, was passed by the 117th United States Congress and signed into law by President Joe Biden on March 11, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the ARPA provides for \$65.1 billion in direct allocation to counties. Lane County anticipates receipt of \$74,212,036 in total, to be paid in two equal payments, the first of which was received on May 19, 2021 and the second payment received on June 9, 2022; and


**WHEREAS**, ARP funds in the amount of \$54,878,000 were allocated to projects in Board Order 21-12-14-08 and \$9,949,000 were allocated to projects in Board Order 22-03-29-14; and

**WHEREAS**, addressing youth suicide in Lane County is essential to the promotion of a Safe and Healthy County;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. ARP funds of \$165,000 are allocated to the following project:
  - a. Youth Suicide Prevention Program
