INCREASING FY23 APPROPRIATIONS IN
THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND 260
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
SAFETY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$182,000

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Department of Public Safety, has been awarded Bureau of Justice Assistance grant in the amount of \$750,000 for a four-year period for enhancements to the Lane County Adult Treatment Court; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the awarded grant is establish equitable access to Adult Treatment Court and to build and sustain infrastructure necessary for equitable access and service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners, per ORS 294.338(2), has the authority to appropriate unforeseen specific purpose grant revenue through a Resolution; and

WHEREAS the need, the purpose, and the amount of the grant are herein described;

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **RESOLVES and ORDERS** as follows:

- **1.** Lane County, through the Department of Public Safety is approved to accept the Bureau of Justice Assistance Adult Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program in the amount of \$750,000 over four years.
- 2. The County Administrator is delegated the authority to sign and execute the resulting grant award with the Bureau of Justice Assistance and any associated sub-contracts.
- 3. Appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, are increased as follows:
