Sustainable Events Services Program



Why should my event use durable dishware instead of disposables?

Reusable dishware consumes much less energy and resources over its lifetime than its disposable counterparts. Event producers report they can offer a value-add to event attendees and that vendors appreciate the cost savings. Attendees report appreciating the service and the event's commitment to sustainability.



Where can I use the dishware and water bottle refill stations?

You can use the Sustainable Events Services Program dishware at community events that attract more than 250 participants. Basin-style water stations require access to a potable/municipal water supply within 50 feet of the placement point.



Who can take part in the Sustainable Events Services Program?

Community events are eligible to participate. This program is not intended for private events.



What reusable dishware is available to be used?

Up to 2,000 plates, 1,500 cups, 1,000 forks, bowls, and spoons are available. In addition to the dishware, up to 10 water bottle refilling stations can be delivered to your public event.



What does the inventory look like?

The durable dishware inventory includes both small and large plates and 20 oz. bowls made from durable white melamine, stainless steel commercial grade metal forks and spoons, and transparent/clear 16-ounce polycarbonate cups. Both style of water stations – with six bottle fillers each – are also available.
